

KIDS Swimming School Guide



I. Fees

Initial registration fee	Annual fee	Lesson fee (4 lessons/month)	Temporary enrollment pause fee

Initial registration fee Please pay the initial registration fee when enrolling.

Annual fee (annually) You will be charged the annual fee starting from the year in which your child started taking classes. The month of reckoning will be April.
*Members enrolling in months other than April will pay a partial annual fee based on their enrolment month.
The total amount of the lesson fee for March and the annual fee will be paid by bank account transfer (the date of withdrawal will be March 14).
If you wish instead to pay at a reception desk, please do so in the first week of March.

Lesson fee (monthly) Payment may be made by bank account transfer or at a reception desk. The date of withdrawal in the case of bank account transfer is the 14th of the month. If you wish to pay at a reception desk, please do so in the first week of the month. Please contact us in advance if your child will be absent from a lesson. You may make use of a make-up lesson system to have your child attend a different lesson than originally scheduled up to two times a month.

Temporary enrollment pause fee (monthly)
Payment may be made by bank account transfer or at a reception desk. The date of withdrawal in the case of bank account transfer is the 14th of the month. If you wish to pay at a reception desk, please do so before the start of your child's temporary enrollment pause. Persons who would like a temporary enrollment pause for their child should request the pause by the 20th of the previous month.
Your temporary enrollment pause may last up to three months.

II. Application

Routine screening will be conducted before the enrolment.

1. Application requirement

To have at least one parent (or grandparent) who is a member of the HILLS SPA.

2. Application

Fill in the application, sign the Letter of consent, and present it with a 4 cm x 3 cm passport type photo (face shot) and the following documents at the school reception.

- Copy of the personal ID of the guardian. (For foreign nationals, a copy of the passport and visa)
- At our discretion, we may ask for a health certificate from the child's physician.

3. Screening and acceptance

We will notify you after the screening.

(* Please note that we cannot accept any inquiries regarding the screening results.)

III. Taking Lessons

< Things to bring >

☐ Swimsuit and swim cap

- For the Pre-school through Primary School Courses, please purchase and have your child wear a KIDS Swimming School-designated swimsuit and swim cap. Designated items are sold at reception desks.

☐ Swim (pool) diapers [For children who have not completed toilet training]

- Swim diapers are sold at the school reception desks, however, if you will be bringing your own, please purchase one of the following.
products: GOON Swimming Pants made by Daio Paper Corporation (大王製紙社製 GOON スイミングパンツ) or moony Mizuasobi Pants made by Unicharm (ユニ・チャーム社製 moony 水あそびパンツ)

☐ Swimming goggles

- No specific items designated by the KIDS Swimming School. Swimming goggles are sold at school reception desks.
- Swimming goggles are not used for KIDS Swimming School grades through 25 to 20 (water familiarization level lessons).

* Bath towels

Please use the provided bath towels. Please refrain from bringing your own bath towels.

- Membership of the KIDS swimming school will be canceled upon the parent's (or grandparent's) membership withdrawal.
